The Manager of the Channel Dry Dock Co informed me just before I left Queenstown, that properly tested anchors had been ordered to complete the anchors for this ship, but they had not arrived when I handed over the district to the local surveyor.

Probably Capt. Attridge has seen these anchors & certificates.
