Before dealing with this case, It is submitted that the Belfast Surveyor be requested to state whether the sizes of cylinders viz. 23" x 42" dia. x 27 strokes are correct. If so he should explain why the safety valves have been adjusted to 95 lbs instead of 70 lbs per square inch as he was instructed in the Secretary's letter of the 14<sup>th</sup> ult.

He should be reminded that the Secretary's letter of the 23<sup>rd</sup> ult informed him that a pressure of 90 lbs could only be approved provided the cylinders were 19" x 42" dia. & the Secretary's letter of the 3<sup>rd</sup> inst. informed that nothing further had to be added.

If therefore the sizes of cylinders are stated on his Report he must take the earliest possible opportunity of adjusting the safety valves of the main boiler to 70 lbs per square inch to entitle the machinery to be classed.
