This vessel is evidently not of that superior description which is contemplated for the 12A grade - Grain cut buttocks - floor beam and buttock heels not in close contact - the shortness of the stiff between the scamp of the keel and keelson - deficiency of transverse bracing - a serious defect in a watership already of exceedingly small scantling - Breast hooks not of the best description - the method of shifting the Butts of the plank, if the Butts be shifted as the sketch would lead us to infer - and in fact all the objections recapitulated in the report of the local Surveyor, are such as should not be made to any 12A ship. Though there is not one which can be singled out to contradict the opinion made by Messrs Pollett respecting deviation from the rules - all the objections being on matters which the rules by inference require to be free from objection -
