I have yours of the 31st March
relative to the Brig "Hibernia" of this Port
No 223 In. That vessel has sailed on 1st October
N.B. before she sailed my Brother had her
with the patent slip ~~which~~ he shipped such
the nails as he could find here and also
had her caulked there was not there time
to put in the Butt end Bolts - on her return
here to sail again put her on the slip here
and prove all the trenails and have
her fastened according to the Regulations
and provide an anchor and some smaller articles
our Inspector told my Brother and others
were necessary - I think the vessel
