We certify that the Wexford packet of Wexford
had in the year 1837 the sum of £200 expended
on her in planking from keel to covering boards
timbering when required ceiling &c and in
the year 1839 had £94 laid out on new
decks &c in 1840 she was caulked all over
in 1843 got an overhaul and is now
in as good condition as any vessel of A. class
sailing out of this Port and sufficient to
take in a cargo of any description
