The remarks of the Chief Ship Surveyor are desired on this case for the consideration of the Classing Committee.



Nature of Survey Condition

This vessel has been examined in dry dock, the bottom cleaned and coated, and the following repairs done due to wear and tear; - the face angles on web frames strengthened, and minor repairs. The main hatchway has been altered to the Surveyor's satisfaction.

It is submitted the vessel is worthy to remain as classed with record of survey, as recommended.
