the forging are The Old Park Forge Ltd. Neepsend, Sheffield.,
the shafts are of Siemens Martin Steel, having a tensile
strength of about 28/32 tons per square inch with an
elongation of about 25%. The sulphur and phosphorous is
approximately .04%.
