E. Dear Sir,

I am in receipt of your letter of the 27th instant respecting the motor of the schooner "OLWEN", and with regard to your remarks I have to inform you that from enquiries made of Messrs. Mortimer & Bacon, it appears that the motor in question has not been built under special survey.

If it is desired to have the motor certificated, it would first be necessary for full particulars of the motor and its shafting to be furnished, so that the matter might be considered. If it is not desired to have the motor certificated, you should still see that the motor is efficiently secured to the seating, that the sea connections, stern tube, screw shaft, are properly fitted, and that reasonable and proper precautions are taken to prevent danger from fire.
