Dear Sir

In reply to your letter of the 2nd May respecting the proposed bulk head of the steel Schooner "Olwen" The Ringend Dockyard Co point out that the deck of this vessel being of wood they are apprehensive that the fitting of the brackets as shown in the approved plan would not be satisfactory. In lieu of brackets they propose to fit a pair of intercostal deck beam angles, one pair on each side of the mid line, with their ends fastened to Nos 10. 11. & 12 deck beams, with the object of distributing the weight on these beams, if you so approve. The approved plans are enclosed for reference which please return with your commands.
