Dear Sir -

We understand that the intention to have the machinery in the Steam Trawler built at Anstruther passed by Lloyds is abandoned. Under these circumstances we presume you do not require to keep the tracing - which we sent with a distinct request that it should be returned. It is our only copy of the drawing, & it is absolutely

necessary that we should have it. We shall however be happy, if you desire it, to send you a copy. It may be worth while to mention, that this set of machinery was contracted for without reference to Lloyds' requirements, and they were consequently not taken into account in designing the boiler. Either the owners of the boat forgot to stipulate it - or - probably - they formed the intention of classing the machinery only as an after thought. Had it been mentioned at first we should have seen that your rules were complied with: - in fact it was a surprise to us to learn that the boiler, in the designing of which we left a good deal of freedom to my Secretary, was in any respect below your standard. We think, however, the boiler is a very good one, & suit for the purpose. Yours faithfully W. Williams & Robinson
