Nature of Survey

Third Survey & Repairs.

The Dundee Surveyor reported frames, reverse frames and plates wasted. The Owners wished to withdraw from re-classing and stated that they had made arrangements for the survey of the vessel by the Bureau Veritas.

The Classing Committee considered the case and in accordance with their decision on the 12th inst. the Owners were informed that provided an opportunity be afforded for a Surveyor to this Society to see on completion the repairs which have been effected, the Committee will on receipt of a report from the Surveyor again take the case into consideration with the object of meeting the wishes of the Owner to leave the character withdrawn and three dots inserted in the Register Book. In a reply dated the 15th inst. the Owners state they will give the Surveyors an opportunity of inspecting the ship at the proper time after the repairs are carried out. They also promise a specification and note of the repairs done, and add that all defects are now being thoroughly repaired at a cost of between £5000 and £6000, and that they have no doubt the Committee will be satisfied with the same.

It is submitted that further action be deferred until the Surveyor has reported on the repairs.
