Dear Mr. Scott

With regard to the remarks in the Classing letter of yesterday, on the S.S. "Loch Rannoch", it is not quite clear to us what is meant by the instructions contained herein.

The Survey of damage requested by the Owners is for Machinery only: the hull has not received any damage. Are we to note the repairs effected to the hull on account of deterioration &c, and report the result promptly to the Committee? The Owners wish us

us only to go on with the Survey of repairs to Machinery and the new Donkey Boiler, their letter does not make this quite clear. And as they have made arrangements to Class the vessel in the Bureau Veritas Book, it seems to me that we can hardly take note of repairs without permission to do so.

Thanking you in anticipation for your kind attention to these points.
