The Surveyors have pointed out the necessary repairs to the Owners, but the vessel has left that port for the Tyne, where the survey is to be completed, and a copy of the report has been forwarded to the Newcastle Surveyors.

It is <sup>submitted</sup> requested the Newcastle Surveyors should be requested to give the case the necessary attention, and they should arrange for the renewal of 135 fms. of <sup>worn</sup> chain cable now on board and for the supplying of 45 fms. additional chain cable to complete the equipment of chain cable.

In the meantime, the vessel's class might remain undisturbed, pending the receipt of a <sup>report</sup> reply from the Newcastle Surveyors.
