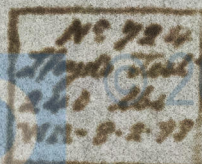
Messrs Goulay Bros & Co, Dunder,
during construction, two steel main boilers
made by them for the Iron Paddle Steamer "Pharos"
of Louth, 240 tons register.

The steel used in the construction of these
boilers has been tested in accordance with the
Society's Rules. The workmanship was examined from
time to time during the progress of the work and found
good, and on completion the boilers were tested in my
presence by hydraulic pressure to 240 lbs per square inch,
when they showed no signs of weakness and were found
light and sound in every respect at that pressure; they
were also examined under steam by the undersigned and
found to be light. The working pressure should
not exceed one hundred and twenty pounds (120 lbs
per square inch.

For the purpose of identification the boilers
have been marked as follows:—
