Nature of Survey _____ S.S. No. *2*

The S.S. No. *2* has now been held, and the following repairs done (due to *wear & tear*) :- rudder bushed, awning deck planking ^{partly} renewed, drain deck sheathing partly renewed, one stroke of deck plating on each side of *80 B* casing & the plating under *Donkey* boiler renewed, 7 floors renewed, 3 beams part renewed, a number of *vertical* frames repaired, awning deck *chustrate* dented for a length of 30 ft, the *hawse* pipe renewed, 120 fms of chain cable of proper size, bought & stowed ^{for repairs} supplied.

It is submitted the vessel is worthy to remain classed

with record of Survey *12-05* and notation of S.S.

No 2-05 P.N.D.05 as recommended.
