S. No. 3 on this vessel is now almost complete, there only remaining the hand pump to test; hangers to supply, and a few minor repairs, which are in hand, to complete the hull. To complete the machinery the safety valves require to be adjusted and engines & boiler examined under steam. I hope to be able to complete the survey on the machinery tomorrow (Tuesday) and the survey on the hull about Wednesday or Thursday of this week.
