

bars, $3 \times 2\frac{1}{2} \times 5/16$;

Main mast, Length 68.0, diamⁱⁿ 19. Plates $7/20 \times 6/12$
Constructed with two plates in
the round, seams single
butts triple rivetted, doubled



all round in way of deck
and fitted with two angle
bars, $2\frac{1}{2} \times 2\frac{1}{2} \times 5/16$.
