Copy of letter dated 2nd February '97, received from Mr. Sandry
of Falmouth.

Sir,

I beg most respectfully to forward two First Entry Reports, one on the tug "CONQUEROR", and the other on the new tug "PENGUIN" built by Messrs Cox & Co. at this port, and regret to have kept them so long after my last visit, but in consequence of damage surveys which call me so much away from home, I have not been able to complete them before. We have the steamer "STRATHDEE" of Glasgow here on fire which I am often requested by Mr. Broad, Lloyd's Agent, to go on board to advise them in cutting deck plates &c.
