


It is submitted the Falmouth Surveyors should be informed that Mr Sandry's letter of the 15<sup>th</sup> inst<sup>d</sup> addressed to the owners of the S.S. "Deerhound" has been forwarded by the owners to this office together with a copy of their letter to Mr Sandry in reply thereto dated 16<sup>th</sup> inst<sup>d</sup>. The owners have also addressed to this office a letter dated 16<sup>th</sup> inst<sup>d</sup> a copy of which should be forwarded to the Falmouth Surveyors for Mr Sandry's remarks thereon.

Mr Sandry should be informed that whatever may be his explanation of the circumstances under which he failed to intimation to the owners at an earlier date that the foremast and certain ropes should be renewed, it is considered that his letter of the 15<sup>th</sup> March addressed to the owners of the S.S. "Deerhound" is a most improper one, being discourteous and offensive in its terms. He should further be informed that it is much regretted that one of the Society's Surveyors should have written such a letter to the owners of a vessel under the Society's Survey and he should be requested to be more careful in the tone and wording of his official correspondence in future. He should also be instructed to forward to this office his survey report on the S.S. "Deerhound" at once.

It is further submitted the owners of the S.S. "Deerhound" should be informed that it is regretted they should have received such a letter as the one complained of from one of the Society's Surveyors and that Mr Sandry has been written to on the subject. They should further be informed that Mr Sandry's report on the "Deerhound" has not yet been received at this office.
