We enclose letter from your Falmouth Surveyor re S/S "Deerhound" to which, we regret we must take exception.

"Deerhound" has just gone through a full survey and new boiler &c, &c, at a cost of considerably over £2000. At the last minute, although steamer was at Falmouth for over two months, ropes are found fault with and foremast condemned. A new foremast has been supplied to the vessel and the ropes are now waiting her in Preston.

We venture to think that a little more politeness and consideration would be beneficial to your Society; we cannot help feeling very sore, and enclose copy of our reply to Mr. Sandry.

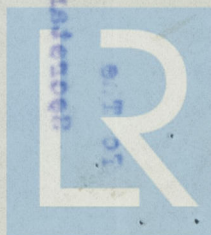
