on the casting that carries the sea infection
or circulating valve
- 2nd That the boiler was built under my survey &

Committee
- 3rd That the pump worked by hand or that can be
so worked in case of necessity refers to the
donkey
- 4th That when I went on board the donkey infection
was already fitted & I did not insist upon
having it removed as I understood at the time
