owner of the wood steamer "Utari" (no of
first entry report 946) that unless hold beams
be fitted she was not eligible to be closed
in the Society Register Book. I beg
leave to inform you that ^{the} owner has now
fitted 6 hold beams 15" x 15" forward of
the engine and boiler room bulkhead
attached satisfactory to the vessel sides with
Oak knees, thus the steamer has now 7
strong hold beams and now the owner
strongly hopes that the Committee will
find her eligible to be closed.
