## REPAIRS

*At Present. Stripped the Yellow Metal and Wood sheathing, dabbled the bottom clean, drove out several hold beam knee bolt and Treennail for inspection which were found in good condition, and renewed. Removed two short shifts of ceiling in lower hold. Starboard side, and renewed with Quebec Oak. Caulked over all, and replaced the Wood Sheathing below the hold. Resheathed the bottom with Yellow Metal over part paper and part felt. (C.S.) Paper below, and upper Course Felt. Overhauled and Repaired all the Rigging and Sails.*
