REPAIRS At Present. Scraped the upper work clean, from the Copper Sheathing to the gunwale, and doubled the ceiling in the lower hold, drove out several deck and hold beam and shelf bolts and treenails for inspection and renewed them. Renewed several planks of ceiling in the lower hold and betwixt decks with Red Pine, and 35 feet of Deck Beam Shelf (Starboard Bow) with Quebec Oak. The fore piece of keelson renewed with Quebec Oak. Patched the Copper Sheathing when required. In February last the Deck and Upper Work painted.
