## REPAIRS

At Present, for Special Survey Scraped the Upper Work clean from the Lower Part of the Wale to the Gunwale. Spoke out several Greenails and Deck Beam Bolt for inspection which were found good and renewed.

Repairs in September 1850 at Wexford; New Waterways and Plank sheers of Red Pine, part new Decks, New Greenailed from the Copper Sheathing up and Caulked over all, New Stations Rails and Bulwarks, New Masts, Gards and Standing Rigging; Some new Nails and Running Rigging.

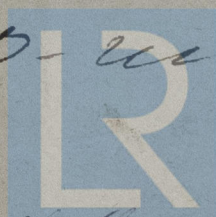
