REPAIRS Of damage at New York in June last

New Plank sheers on the Starboard side from the Fore to the Main Rigging of American White Oak; New Stanchions, Rails and Bulwarks in that space  
Caulked the Upper Works and Decks.

At present stripped the Yellow Metal Sheathing, Cleaned the Bottom and Caulked from the Keel to the Wales and Resheathed the Bottom with Yellow Metal over Felt
