Scraped the Upper Work Chain from the lower part of the Wale to the Gunwale, drove out several Deck and Hold Beam Bolts and Screws for Inspection which were found good and renewed  
 Stripped the Yellow Metal Sheathing and Cleaned the Bottom, Caulked from the Keel to the Wale and Re-sheathed with Yellow Metal over Felt  
 New Windlass

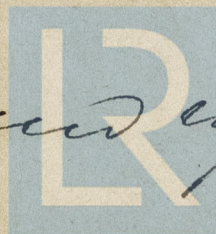
