REPAIRS For Special Survey, Scraped the Upper Works Clean from the Gunwale to the lower part of the Wale, drove out several Treennails and Beam Bolts for inspection, Stripped the Yellow Metal Sheathing and Cleaned the Bottom, renewed a short piece of Sheerstrake on the Starboard Bow and a piece of Waterway on the Larboard Side, New Upper Rudder Grog Caulked from the Keel to the Third Beam on Deck and Reheated the Bottom with Yellow Metal over Paper Below and Felt above

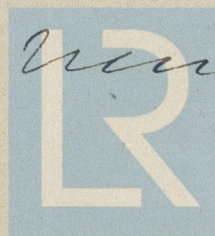
