Shipped the Yellow Metal Sheathing and Cleaned the Bottom
 Scraped the Upper Works from the Gunwale to the Light Water Mark and
 drove out Treennails and Deck and Hold Beam Bolts for Inspection
 Renewed a number of Deck and Hold Beam Bolts and Treennails
 Repaired and refastened the Ceiling with Gump Bolts and Spikes
 pulked from the Keel to the Wale and Reheathed the Bottom with
 Yellow Metal over Felt
