REPAIRS Of Damage, stripped the Yellow Metal Sheathing and Cleared
the Bottom, Primed off 1 1/2 Inch of the lower side of the Keel and
renewed all the Bolts in it and the Keelson with 1 1/8 Inch Iron Bolts
Brought a new False Keel 4 Inches Bolted diagonally to the Main
Keel with Yellow Metal
Renewed a number of Vreenails on the Starboard Ridge
Cantered the Bottom and Wales and Re-sheeted with Yellow Metal
over Felt


