## REPAIRS

Stripped the Yellow Metal Sheathing and Cleaned the Bottom  
 Scraped bright from the Light Water Line to the Waterways  
 Included, Drove out Greenails and Beam Bolts for Special  
 Survey which were found in good Condition and renewed  
 Caulked from Keel to Waterway included, Planking and Timber  
 Sheathing the Bottom with Yellow Metal to the 8 feet Water Line
