Off Damage; Renewed Sine Stanchions on Starboard Side  
and three on Starboard with English Oak; Main Rail and Bulwarks  
from Main Mast forward Starboard Side, and Thirty Five feet on  
Starboard Side; Fore and Main Chain Plates and Bolts Starboard  
Side repaired and renewed  
Head Rail and Porting Starboard Side and Starboard repaired and  
refastened; Bowsprit Chock refitted; Caulked from the Bellow  
Metal Sheathing to Waterway beam included, Quarter deck and part  
of Main Deck  
Some Running Rigging and Sails replaced
