REPAIRS Off Damage; Shipped the Yellow Metal Sheathing, Cleaned the Bottom, Dubbed the Wales and Blackstrakes, eight being partially renewed, Lower Strakes of Wales both sides except the Fore and After Shifts, and One Shift of Blackstrake Starboard Side between Main and Mizen Masts with Battic Oak; All the Churn Bolts to hold Beam Chaining Knee and through Clamp Bolts of Churn Caulked over all, Sheathed the Wales and Lower Black Strakes with 1 1/4 in. Rock Elm over Felt and Caulked Sheathed the Bottom with Yellow Metal over Felt Repaired the Masts and Bulwarks; Refastened the Madder Bands New Fore Card, New Main Hatchway Coverings; Several new Planks in Poop deck Aft
