REPAIRS Upper Bolt in Hold Beam Lodging Wreck and Short Bolt to
Hold Beam Hanging Wreck, and Clamps and the Second Breasthook
up all shifted out, Also the Through Bolt Bolt as high as the Upper
Part of Wale and renewed of Yellow Metal and an Extra Short
Bolt introduced into each of the Bolts to the Upper part of Wale
A new False Keel Fore and Aft of American Elm and Beech fastened
with Yellow Metal
The Short Run Bolt Bolt driven up and Plugged
Yellow Metal Sheathing Stripped, Keel recaulked from Keel to Gunwale
Bottom Resheathed with Yellow Metal over Felt
