## REPAIRS of damage.

Yellow metal sheathing stripped off bottom, Midship piece of Keel, 30ft in length renewed with Am. Elm, and two fore hoods of bottom on port side renewed with Tamarac. Repairs of defects. - Upper piece of Stem renewed with Eng. Oak; Stems of Head & Head rails also renewed; The quarter timber on each side renewed with Eng. Oak five after hoods on each side with Tamarac, and the whole of the Stern berthing with Red Pine. - The vessel recaulked from Keel to Gunwales & resheathed with Yellow metal on felt.
