The keel... all fore and aft... renewed with British and Rock Elm... the garboards and second strake all fore and aft on the port side and the fore hood of garboards strake on the starboard side renewed with Rock Elm -

The vessel caulked from plank sheers to keel and the bottom resheathed with Yellow Metal on felt.
