down the River Clyde on 18<sup>th</sup> March 1881  
Propeller blades broken, & stern bush found broken, when shaft  
was drawn for examination; the outer bearing of shaft being carried  
away in rudder port, these have been renewed & replaced  
Examined sea cocks, & found them in good condition,  
Examined Main Boilers which are of steel & found them in very good  
condition.

General Observations, Opinion, and Recommendation: The above repairs having been  
satisfactorily carried out by Messrs D. & W. Henderson, the Machinery is now  
in good order & safe working condition, & eligible in my opinion  
to remain in the Register Book on noted
