REPAIRS, OR EXAMINATION AS PER RULE

Cause of Repairs to be clearly stated.

Damage repairs.

The damage stated to have been sustained on 29th Decr. 1884, through being in collision with a dredger in Bilbao river has now been made good as follows:-

One outside plate, on the port bow, at about the 12 feet water line, and second from the stem, renewed; one plate in the strake above the first named, slightly cracked and indented at the lower landing edge between two frames - efficiently doubled on the inside between the frames.
