REPAIRS, OR EXAMINATION AS PER RULE

This vessel it is stated grounded in Gibraltar Bay.

The bottom of the vessel found rubbed bare of paint especially in the flat on each side. Recommended that the bottom be cleaned and recoated - but the vessel was launched without this being done.

The keel pin of the rudder refitted and riveted in place.

The vessel having been recently surveyed and reported, no further examination was made at this time - all said to be in good and complete condition.
