Annual Survey

Engines:- Cylinders, pistons, Slide Valves and pumps opened up and examined and found in good condition; propeller also examined. Sea cocks and valves overhauled. Crank shaft, pins, thrust and tunnel shafting carefully inspected. Low-pressure valve rod turned up and new brass bushes fitted.

Boilers:- Main and donkey boilers thoroughly examined internally and externally and found in good condition. New check valve and new safety valves for donkey boiler. The safety valves of main and donkey boilers tested under steam.

General Observations, Opinion, and Recommendation :-


