The vessel has been placed on the above slipway. The propeller stern-bush & sea-cocks examined and found in good condition. To allow for more clearance between the propeller blades and stern post the propeller has been fitted $\frac{3}{4}$ " further on the shaft.

It is submitted that this vessel is eligible to remain as classed M 15/10/85
