 When the vessel was in dry dock the sea cocks & valves, propeller & were all examined. Propeller shaft removed and outer bearing in stern tube re-filled with wood.
 Donkey boiler re-lubed. New gland for the slide valve rod, also glands for the P. piston rods top & bottom.
