With the exception of the High pressure piston and pumps the machinery of this vessel has been opened out for survey and there were examined the L. Cylinder, slide valves, crank shaft & shafing also main & donkey boilers, safety valves, pipes &c.

When the vessel was in Dock the propeller^{shaft} was drawn in and examined. a new key fitted and the stern tube bearing refitted with wood. Sea cocks, valves &c overhauled. It is stated that the H. P piston & pumps were opened & examined by owners at London during last voyage to Glasgow.
