The engines & boilers of this vessel opened out for repairs, surveyed and there were examined the cylinders pistons, valves, shafting, pumps, pipes & also the main boiler over all parts, safety valves &c.

When the vessel was on the slipway the sea cocks, valves, propeller & connections all overhauled. Propeller removed & shaft drawn, new brass liner fitted & stern tube re-fitted with wood.

This submitted that this vessel is eligible to have L.M.C. 12.85 recorded. J.M. 31/12/85

General Observations, Opinion, and Recommendation:—


