REPAIRS, OR EXAMINATION AS PER RULE *Part B.B. No. 3.*
 The lining of the after saloon, between the main and spar decks, and extending over 21 frame spaces on the starboard side and 22 ditto on the port side, now stripped off; the iron work of the sides of the vessel there, cleaned, examined, found satisfactory, and recoated.

The Owners state that they intend to renew the boilers and to complete the B. B. No. 3. on the return of the vessel from her next voyage.
