Steam raised in main boiler and safety valves adjusted. Stockhold steam gauge not in working order. It was recommended that gauge be removed for overhaul previous to vessel sailing, and the Engineer in charge undertook to carry this out.


The safety valves were found in good working condition and the boiler quite tight at working pressure. It is submitted that the machinery remain as classed.
