This vessel placed on slipway for damage to hull - Examined the sea connections, propeller & fastenings also connections between engine & boiler - One brass set pin to stem tube nut broken off - Lapping round shaft near propeller bars carried away some amount on blade flanges broken - stated to have been caused by rope getting round shaft. These parts have now been attended to.

General Observations, Opinion, and Recommendation:—

Except the above small details no damage was found to have been sustained to the machinery of this vessel and I am of opinion it is eligible to remain as classed in the Register Book.
