When this vessel was on the Slipway examined the sea cocks & valves, propeller & fastenings, also examined the machinery externally as far as possible owing to the vessel having been aground & in collision in the River Clyde on the 11th February but engines & boiler not opened out and there was no preparation for survey.
Suction pipe in Aft well damaged. has been repaired.

General Observations, Opinion, and Recommendation :—
