The Main boilers & engines of this vessel opened out for survey and these were examined the crankshaft, pumps, cylinders & slide valves. Permanent repairs to low pressure slide have now been satisfactorily carried out, consisting of new slide valve & face. Main boiler & safety valve examined. One spring much wasted by corrosion, has been removed & replaced by a new one. Steam raised & safety valves adjusted.

General Observations, Opinion, and Recommendation:—
