REPAIRS, OR EXAMINATION AS PER RULE, FOR Damage & defects this decay.
 The bulwarks each side in front of Bridge House, indented & fractured, set fair covering pieces fitted inside. Forecastle plating above funnel damaged port side, now repaired. Guard Stations from both sides. Two anchor D-rivets renewed. About 300 ft of Dk plating renewed with G Pine & the whole recaulked, where necessary. Rudder finlets rebushed. The outside generally made of nos 1.2.3 holds now repainted.
